## **STATE UNIVERSITY STATUS GRANTED TO THE INSTITUTE**

The Transplant University bill was presented on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2015 in the Gujarat Legislative Assembly by Hon'ble Minister of Health Shree Nitinbhai Patel. After discussion for one hour, Honorable Speaker Shree Ganpatsinh Vasava declared that bill is passed unanimously by all the members of the Legislative Assembly. The Vidhan Sabha was witness to the second historical moment of its life when IKDRC-ITS was officially given the status of "Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences" (GUTS) which was dream of Prof. Trivedi for a long time! Everybody spoke highly of IKDRC-ITS and Prof. Trivedi in particular for his commitment to common man. Shree Shaktisinh Gohel, Hon. Member of opposition party, reminded the house that decades back Prof. Trivedi had requested him to introduce a bill for Human Organ Transplantation to the house as a member of the opposition party and the ruling party had gladly accepted it. This second bill of The Transplant University has made the state of Gujarat proud! This will be the first University of Transplantation in the world and not only will be the medical fraternity but the house and the common man will be benefitted by it. The nation's 66<sup>th</sup> Republic Day was celebrated in the institute by flag hoisting of the national tricolor by Director, Dr. H L Trivedi. All the staff members and patients of the institute joined on this occasion to pay respect to the national flag. After a short address by the Director, Deputy Director and Shree Madhav Ramanuj, Chief of H.R.D. section, the assembled members soon went to hear the Ramkatha discourses.

## **MASTER CLASS AND LIVE OPERATIVE WORKSHOP IN PEDIATRIC UROLOGY CONDUCTED BY PROF. MODI AND TEAM**

Prof. Modi conducted a live operative workshop in Pediatric Urology on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> January 2015 for which Prof. Jack Elder, a legend in Pediatric Urology, Robotic Surgery and urology from Henry Ford Hospital, Detroit, USA, was invited as an international faculty. The local operating faculty included Prof. Pranjal Modi himself and his team members Prof. Syed Jamal Rizvi and Dr. Mitul Parikh. This workshop met grand success.

## **DECEASED DONOR ORGAN TRANSPLANTATION**

**Smt Nanduben Kurjibhai Lungaaria** was a 55 years old housewife from Rajkot. Her

husband is a farmer. She had developed hypertension recently used to complain of frequent headaches. On 9<sup>th</sup> January, she developed severe headache for which she took metacin. However there was no relief and on the next day which was Saturday, she requested her family members to take her to the hospital. She was taken to Wockhardt hospital under the care of Dr. Kant Jogani. She was found to have progressing brain hemorrhage. She was operated upon to control the bleeding vessels however all the efforts went futile and eventually she was declared brain dead. Drs. Divyesh Viroja and team joined Dr. Jogani in explaining the situation to the family and motivated them to donate her organs. The family agreed upon organ donation. One kidney was given to 34 years old Kashmiraben S. Chevli, a mentally retarded lady with hypothyroidism and chronic kidney disease, from Surat. She was on our waiting list for the last 1.5 years. Second kidney was given to 44 years old Shreeram R. Kunvar, a factory laborer from Vadodara who was on our waiting list for last 1.5 years due to kidney failure associated with ADPKD. These transplants were performed on 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2015 and both the patients are doing well.

**Shree Pintubhai Jivabhai Baraiyya** was a young man of 25 years, working as a laborer in diamond polishing factory at Talaja

near Bhavnagar. On the morning of kite-flying day on 14<sup>th</sup> January while flying kites from the terrace of the factory with co-workers, he suddenly lost balance and fell down from the terrace. He was immediately taken to Sir T. Hospital in Bhavnagar where CT scan revealed a massive brain hemorrhage. Dr. Kabaria, the treating Neurosurgeon declared him brain dead eventually. The family was motivated for organ donation to which they agreed and our team was summoned in. One kidney was given to 48 years old Hasmukhbhai Behcharbhai Jhalaworking as an officer in Vadodara Municipal Corporation and who was on our waiting list for the last 15 months. He had undergone cadaver kidney transplantation due to hypertension causing kidney failure in our institute on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2013. This graft was unfortunately lost very soon due to technical reasons. The second kidney was given to 47 years old housewife from Surat named Rekhaben Kanjibhai Ghelani. She too had been transplanted for kidney failure due to unknown reasons in our institute on 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2013 with husband's kidney. However she lost this kidney due to technical reasons and was on our waiting list for the last 10 months. These transplants were performed on **18<sup>th</sup> January, 2015** and all the patients are doing well.

**Smt Raiben Ramanbhai Patel** was

a 60 years old housewife from village Khoraj in Gandhinagar district. She used to support her husband in farming in addition to helping the household work to her daughter-in-law. She was suffering from hypertension since a long time. She had developed slurring of speech for which she was brought to Trisha hospital in Nirnayanagar in Ahmedabad on 7<sup>th</sup> February, '15. She was found to have massive brain hemorrhage and was quickly supported with ventilatory services. One of her relatives, a businessman named Mukeshbhai was explained by the doctors that she was in critical condition and they were likely to lose her soon. He was aware of organ donation. There was a marriage ceremony in the family during this period. So he requested the treating doctors to allow him to donate her organs to our institute. He met Prof. Trivedi and explained about all the situation and their keen interest in donating her organs for suffering patients in our institute. She was quickly shifted to our institute on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2015. On the same day, she had started worsening and hence both kidneys were retrieved and transplanted in to the body of 70 years old Smt. Ravindrakumari P. Jadeja from Ahmedabad, suffering from chronic kidney disease due to hypertension. She was on our waiting list for the last 10 months. The body of Raiben was taken with all honor after the family marriage ceremony was over. Liver was transplanted in to

Shaileshbhai M. Patel, 43 years old man from Vadodara who developed end stage liver failure due to alcoholic cirrhosis. He was on our waiting list for the last 1.5 months. These transplants were performed on **8<sup>th</sup> February, 2015** and both are doing well.

**Vishnu Mansukhbhai Baraasraa** was a young boy of 16 years from Jothpar village near Machhu dam in Morvi. He was studying in 10<sup>th</sup> standard. One day his school teacher called his parents to take him home since the child had developed fever. They took him to Nakh lakh hospital in Morvi where he recovered after treatment. Again the episode recurred at school and once again he was sent home. This time he was moved to intensive care unit of Landmark hospital in Rajkot. There he was found to have liver problem with high level of ammonia in his blood. During recovery phase there, he suddenly convulsed and in a short span of 3 days, he was eventually declared brain dead. The family was shocked however they were motivated for organ donation. The family agreed and he was shifted to Wockhardt hospital. Dr. Divyesh Viroja, our alumni in that hospital invited our team to procure his organs. One kidney was given to 32 years lady named Anu S. Lodha who had lost her kidney due to juvenile diabetes associated kidney failure. She was on our waiting list since 1.5 years. The second kidney was given to a young man of 22 years named Gaurav V. Soni

studying in 12<sup>th</sup> standard at Jodhpur, Rajasthan. He had lost his kidneys due to vesico-ureteric reflux associated kidney failure. He was on our waiting list for the last 2 years. These transplants were performed on **22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2015** and all the patients are doing well.

**Smt Savitaben Dahyabhai Prajapati** was a 52 years old house-laborer from Ahmedabad. While going to work in a bunglaw at about 8 o'clock in the evening on 20<sup>th</sup> February,'15, she was hit by a speeding motorbike rider. She fell on the roadside where her head hit on the cornerstone and left her unconscious. Passersby saw this accident and rushed to the scene. They recognized her and called her daughter who was at that time working in a nearby bunglaw. They moved her to Pukhraj hospital and then to Panchsheel hospital. Eventually the family realized that she was not going to recover. And then together they decided to bring her to our institute. They wanted to consult our institute to find out the truth about her health status and had already decided to donate her organs to our patients if she was to die of brain death. She was brought to our institute on 22<sup>nd</sup> February. Her condition deteriorated and eventually organs were retrieved. One kidney was given to 58 years old housewife named Jyotiben Dave from Nadiad who was on our waiting list for last 1.5 years. Jyotiben had a single kidney which was lost. Second kidney was given to 32 years old housewife named

Pinky H. Shrimalini from Ahmedabad who was on our waiting list for last 1 year. She had undergone kidney transplantation in our hospital on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2012 with cadaver kidney. This graft was lost to chronic rejection. These transplants were performed on **23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2015** and both are doing well.

**Shree Ratansha Sawaksha Pardiwala** was a 68 years old man from Kila-pardi near Valsad. He was a land owner with vast farm lands. On 6<sup>th</sup> March, he developed headache in afternoon which progressed gradually to reach serious dimensions. He was taken to Amit hospital in Valsad where brain hemorrhage was diagnosed. The treating doctors instructed the family to shift him to either Mumbai or Surat immediately. He was taken to a Parsi general hospital opposite Breach Candy hospital in Mumbai. He was maintained there till 11<sup>th</sup> March however there were no signs of recovery. So the family took him back to the hospital of Dr. Kureshi in Pardi where he was declared brain dead. Some Parsis who had previously donated organs, motivated them for cadaver organ donation. His daughter Tina Pardiwala accepted the advice and agreed to donate organs of her father to our needy patients. Thus our team was summoned. Both kidneys were given to 46 years old Vilasben Chandubhai Kothia from Ahmedabad, suffering from chronic kidney disease due to IgA nephropathy. She was on our waiting list for the last 1 year. This

transplant was performed on **12<sup>th</sup> March, 2015** and Smt. Vilasben is doing well.
