Special achievements and experience in transplantation surgery:

- 1 Pioneered retroperitoneoscopic donor nephrectomy at IKDRC-ITS and has largest experience in this field in India. Has performed over 750 retroperitoneoscopic donor nephrectomy including over 225 cases on right side.
- 2 Largest experience of performing dual kidney transplantation in India
- 3 Establishes intercity cadaver transplant program in Gujarat under guide of Prof. H L Trivedi
- 4 Has started liver transplantation in The State of Gujarat from 28th May, 2008. Till date 31 liver transplants are carried out at IKDRC-ITS
- 5 First successful non-heart beating liver transplantation in India was done in 2010
- 6 First successful combined liver and kidney transplantation was performed from deceased donor in India in 2010

- 7 The first successful laparoscopic kidney transplant in the country/Asia was done on 15th February, 2010. Till date 60 laparoscopic kidney transplantations are performed, the largest series in the world (unpublished).
- 8 The first successful laparoscopic en bloc kidney transplant from non-heart beating deceased donor in the world was performed on 30th December 2010 (unpublished).
