Dr. S.I..Husain also said that on 27th March 2016 at the NEC meeting at Jaipur Dr. Atul Kr. Singh President Rajasthan State Branch promised to give 15 new Life Members from Rajasthan State Branch shortly.

Dr. R.K.Acharya, General Secretary ,Rajasthan State Branch promised at the NEC meeting dated 28.8.16 at Goa that he would submit a list of 15 new Life Members from Rajasthan after the meeting.

***Resolved unanimously that the list of New Life Members of the HMAI since 27th March 2016 be approved.**

ITEM NO.05-Progress reports of the XXTH All India Homoeopathic Congress 2016 to be held at Jaipur.

Dr.R.K.Acharya the Treasurer of the XXth All India Homoeopathic Congress-2016 to be held at Jaipur submitted the progress report of the Congress. He said that the XXTH All India Homoeopathic Congress-2016 would be held at the B.M.Birla Auditorium at Jaipur, Rajasthan on 17th & 18th December 2016.Preparation for the Congress had been going on in a full swing. He distributed the leaflets of the Congress. There were 13 R.C.Members but not single Patrons had come. He wanted all types of help and cooperation from the NEC members to make the Jaipur Congress a grand success.

Dr.V.C.Acharya pursued Dr. R. K. Acharya to request all the NEC members and office bearers to be Patrons or R.C.Members.

Dr. R.K.Acharya accordingly requested all the NEC members to be the R.C.Members or Patrons and to a large numbers of delegate and advertisements.

Dr. G.Patil instantly gave consent to be the Patron.

ITEM NO.06 -Report of the Central Office Bearers and NEC Members of the HMAI.

[Dr.Ramjee Singh, President, CCH, Dr Arun Bhasme, Vice President CCH , Dr.Lalit Verma, Secretary CCH, Dr. S.M. Desarda accompanied by Dr.Shyamal Kr.Mukherjee, Dr.Rajat Chatterjee , Dr. Biplab Kundu & Dr. Naryan Debnath came to the meeting at 12-30pm just prior to the discussion of Item No.06]

As requested by Dr.S.I.Husain, (1) Dr.Ashoke Kr.Banerjee, Organizing Secretary General of zone-2, HMAI, from West Bengal, (2) Dr. Kautuk P Bhatikar, General Secretary Goa State Branch, (3) Dr.Rajan Kalpande from Nagpur, Maharashtra, (4) Dr.Y.K.Goswami from U.P. as NEC members, (5) G.P.Patil, Organizing Secretary General from M.P., (6) Dr.Juneja from Delhi, (7) Dr.Shivang Swaminarayan, General Secretary, Gujarat State Branch submitted their respective reports and activities.

Dr. Dominic Dias, Vice-President, Goa State Branch consented to hold the XXIst All India Homoeopathic Scientific Seminar -2017 at Goa and said that the best time to hold the same would be June to September and from September onward it would be the pick season for the tourists .

Dr.S.I.Husain read out the reports of Dr.Anil Kr.Singh of U.P. and Dr.H.D.Jaiswal, ex-General Secretary of the West Bengal State Branch. He requested all the State Branches to follow the West Bengal State Branch model to hold the monthly organizational meetings and scientific discussion as a part of the CME on a fixed Sunday of every month. He also informed that the inauguration of the long cherished dream, the HMAI Bhawan at Kolkata would be held on 25th September, 2016(Sunday) and invited all to attend the ceremony.

Dr. Biplab Kumar Kundu said that with ethical issues a clinical regulation & Homoeopathy was taken up a subject topic of the Scientific Seminar of the XXth All India Homoeopathic Congress-2016

Dr. D. B. Dhakulkar flashed about how they organized the XIXth All India Homoeopathic Scientific Seminar in January, 2016 at Nagpur.

Dr. G. P. Patil furnished that 1, 30,000 Medical check up through the free Homoeopathic Medical camps in M.P. were possible and how they tried to motivate the patients towards Homoeopathy. All the activities had been V.D.O. graphed. He showed some pictures of his activities.

Dr. Juneja of Delhi requested for the awareness for the dehydration etc.

Dr. Shivang Swaminarayan from Gujrat furnished the activities particularly of the Baroda units with the CME and awareness about Homoeopathic. He activated all units of Gujarat.

Dr. Shyamal Kr. Mukherjee being Chairman of the Trust of WB state branch, HMAI elaborated the description of the HMAI Bhawan with status report and invited all to the Inaugural Ceremony of the HMAI Bhawan on 25th September, 2016 (Sunday) at Kolkata.

Dr. Shyamal .K. Mukherjee said that the HMAI is a democratic organization through which he along with other 3 members was elected from West Bengal to the CCH which is also a democratic Homoeopathic Institution of the Central Govt. The apex body of Homoeopathic Education where he belonged to as a members. The CCH visited that Homeopathic Medical College. After a sudden visit many colleges were going with seizing admission without amnesty. The AYUSH department was the policy maker and responsible for the financial allotment to the colleges. So, deputation would be given to the AYUSH department for the permission for the admission to the NIH and other Homeopathic medical colleges & Hospitals and for the recruitment for the vacant posts.

He again said that with all the help and cooperation they were able to construct the HMAI Bhawan at Kolkata, the pride of the Homoeopaths.

Dr. V. C. Acharya said that the CCH should be kind to the HMAI, professional organization.

Dr. Ramjee Singh referred to the part. A & Part-B Homoeopaths, Part-A belonged to DMS, DHMS, BHMS, the institutionally educated Homoeopaths but not only that BHMS doctors should prescribe. Policy of the Govt. Must be implemented for all. The 'Niti Ayog' was under the MIC i.e. Medical Commission of India. The 'IMA' is a very strong organization and fought always for their demands. The separate Govt. sought for their own people in the Committee of MCI and the commission was formed with the bourocrats like a lawyer an IAS and laymen without any medical Practitioners. Then what could a Professional Commission expect? Democracy was hampered. So, the HMAI must have to be strong enough like the IMA. In the committee.

most of the members were in favor of Ayurveda but not of Homoeopathy. So, the HMAI should try to give deputation to the State Govt. as well as to the Central Govt. for the unification of implementation of the govt. Rates in Homoeopathy also. He requested the HMAI to submit its issues to the Govt.

Dr.Arun Bhasme referred to Dr.Shyamal Kr. Mukherjee's grievance and said what Dr.Ramjee Singh said was his (Dr.Bhasme's) saying also. He requested to submit all demands to the AYUSH where all were nominated members of the respective government. He also requested first to try to raise objection to from the commission with the nominated persons only instead of the expertised persons.

Dr.Biplab kundu urged open the NEC to hold the meeting an academic affairs only.

Dr.Rajat Chatterjee (i) asked whether Homoeopathy was Science or not. The Government had formed 4 committees with one lawyer, one magician and one quack Homoeopathy but in the CCH 54 Members were from Homoeopathic physicians. There was a Homoeopathic Director in West Bengal. But in the Govt. there was a W.B.C.S. who did not know about Homoeopathy. So, he requested to make a 3 Men Committee to be empowered to discuss about that matter.

(ii) The CCH was only for academic affairs. The CCRH did nothing a research. So, the HMAI should guide any problem or fault of the CCH & CCRH.

Dr.Bhaskar Bhatt supported Dr.Rajat Chatterjee. The change was found in the Govt. Level. Nominated members of the Govt. knew nothing about Homoeopathy.

Dr.Lalit Varma the Secretary of the CCH said that only IHP worked but no other Homoeopathic organization did so.

Dr.Ramjee Singh referred to the 6 months course for Allopathic Doctors learning with Materia Medica Organon, Pharmacology etc was allowed to practice homoeopathy. So, Homoeopathy was going to die the issue was placed in the CCH meeting and was cancelled there. In Kerala all the doctors belonged to the IMA, the President of which was Dr.S.Agarwal.

Dr. S. I. Husain said that Dr. Sahani, Chairman Education sub- committee did nothing during this period. He also said that funding of the HMAI office with Rs.75/- per head for 2 years was nothing or inadequate to run the office and all other subscriptions went to the corpus fund. So, the HMAI should think about the cost of running or maintaining its office.

Dr.Arun Bhasme distributed the draft of a letter complaining against the formation of the commission with the not Homoeopathic nominated persons and requested all to send their complain to the "Niti Ayog" committee personally as well as organizationally from the HMAI (Central) & State Branches.

***Resolved unanimously that the report of the office bearers General Secretaries & Presidents other State Branches be adapted.**

All the members present stood up and observed one minute's silence to pay homage to the departed soul of Dr.Arun Bhasme's revered father. "May his soul be rested in piece".

ITEM NO.07 – To discuss and decide about the subscription of the journal and their distribution.

Dr.Divakar Tiwari made a complain that there was no material in the journal for publication.

Dr.Shivang Swaminarayan requested the members to suggest about the contents, subjects articles, and activities information of India and the countries abroad and plans and programmes of the journal and to utilize the information technology through e-mail.

Dr.Biplab Kundu suggested for planning of the content from January to March and so on.

Dr.V.C.Acharya wanted suggestions from the readers and typed news in short for the journals otherwise it would take much time, staff for retyping the sent materials and be costly and times consuming. The articles should come through the Scientific Standing Committee. He invited various matters from those who dealt with the internet for the news and views only the gist of which would be published. He wanted to run the journal and the suggestion from Dr.Shivang Swaminarayan and he (Dr.Acharya) would highly thankful to those who would help him.

Dr.Bhaskar Bhatt suggested job distribution among 5 or 6 persons of the committee for printing and publishing the journal.

Dr.S.I.Husain invited suggestion about the subscription for the non members of the HMAI and requested all the N.C. & NEC members to be the subscribers of the Journal.

Dr.V.C.Acharya invited subscribers for 5 years together and they would get 1(one) year's free journals.

Dr. Keyur Majumder, Dr.Piyush Joshi, Dr.Bhaskar Bhatt etc, subscribed Rs.1000/- (Rupees are thousand) only for 5 years together instantly.

***Resolved unanimously that the suggestion be invited for the contents, articles, news & views in short in type to publish in the journal and those who would submit 5 years subscription Rs.1, 000/- together would get one year's journal free and the matters i. e. Information's from India and abroad be invited from those who deal with the internet and fees for non-HMAI members is Rs.300/- only.**

ITEM NO.08 – To discuss about the CME programme at Unit, State and Central levels proposed by Dr.Keyur Majumder.

Dr.Keyur Majumder read out the draft proposal of the CME (Continuing Medical Education) credit points for registered Homoeopaths and distributed the copies among the members.

Dr.S.I.Husain thanked Dr. Keyur Majumder for his draft proposal.

***Resolved unanimously that the draft proposal about the CME programmed by Dr.Keyur Majumder is adopted and all were requested to go through and comment.**

ITEM NO.09- To discuss and decide about the membership of the HMAI for the Homoeopathic practitioners of the Foreign Countries and their fees or opening of an International Wing of the HMAI.

Dr.S.I.Husain informed the house that two Homoeopathic practitioners from Bangladesh and one from Pakistan wanted to be the members of the HMAI. So, they could be called the Overseas Life Members (Associates) having no voting rights.

Dr. Gangadhar Mukherjee asked whether the Constitution permitted.

Dr.Keyur Majumder read out the rule 14.6 of the constitution of the HMAI.

Dr.Bhaskar Bhatt suggested that they might be awarded Life Members (Associate) or the overseas members.

Dr.Swaminarayan put an objection that there would be problems to take the foreign associate members as the members of the HMAI were not aware of their qualifications. Their membership might be for one or two years only but not for Life time against \$ 200 or \$ 400. So, the HMAI would have no need of the 4 or 5 overseas members.

***Resolved unanimously that the Item No.09 be dropped.**

ITEM NO.10 - *To discuss about the proposal for awarding honorary membership of the HMAI.*

Dr.S.I.Husain read the resolution taken up by the SEC meeting of the W.B State Branch held on 4.08.2016 that Dr.G.P.Sarkar, the Founder of the Dr.Malati Allen trust be awarded the awarding Honorary membership of the W.B State Branch of the HMAI and it was forwarded to the next NEC meeting of the HMAI for approval.

Dr.Shivang Swaminarayan asked the purpose of the HMAI to have the honorary member.

Dr.V.C.Acharya vehemently opposes the proposal that it might help the financial gain of the HMAI but without the consent of the related person. So, the proposal could not be approved.

Dr.Diwakar Tiwari, Dr.Keyur Majumder supported Dr.V.C.Acharya

***Resolved unanimously that the Item No.10 be dropped.**

ITEM NO.11- *Discuss about the draft proposal of the Homoeopathy Vision-2020 proposed by Dr.Neeraj Pasricha.*

Dr.S.I.Husain informed that the draft proposal of the Homoeopathic Vision-2020 proposed by Dr. Neeraj Pasricha was sent earlier to the NEC members through e-mail and a few feed backs i. e. only 3 suggestions came.Dr. Subhas Singh, Dr. Gangadhar Mukherjee etc.

The house wanted time to go through the draft proposal and to send their suggestion.

***Resolved unanimously that the Item No.11 be deferred to the NEC meeting to be held later on after getting more proper suggestion on the draft proposal of the Homoeopathic Vision-2020.**

ITEM NO.12-*Any other matter with the permission of the chair.*

Dr.V.C.Acharya informed that the HMAI had to pay 20% income tax as the organization had no 80G (Income tax Exemption Certificate).

Dr.Swaminarayan was requested by Dr.V.C.Acharya to solve the income tax matter.

Dr. Diwaker Tiwari suggested revising the accounts.

Dr.Gangadhar Mukherjee, Dr.Susanta Saha and Dr.Y.K.Goswami took part in the discussion and supported Dr.Diwakar Tiwari.

Dr.S.I.Husain informed that the CCH was the department under the Central Govt. and the status of the secretary of the CCH should be the same status of the Joint Secretary of the Govt. but his scale was not equal to that of the Joint Secretary. So, the AYUSH should look into the Scale status of its secretary.

Dr.Shivang Swaminarayan said that the govt. of India had drafted for the National AYUSH policy and they could have only four months time after the circulation of the draft to comment and what they had to do? He suggested that they should be proactive.

Dr.Susanta Saha suggested to form the Student's wing, Medical officer's wing, etc, of the HMAI in Unit, State and Central levels.

As there was no others item to discuss the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair .
