DR. JAMES TYLER KENT

Born:- 31-03-1849

Died :- 06-06-1916



The son of Stephen Kent and Caroline, James Tyler Kent, was born on 31st March 1849 at Woodhull of New York State in U.S.A., the most important homoeopath after Hahnemann.

Primary Schooling at Franklin School in Pratts burgh and secondary education at Woodhull Academy. He graduated from Madison University at Hamilton, New York. Then he got Ph.D. and A.M. from the same university. After qualifying himself as a doctor of medicine from faculty of Bellevue Medical college he attended Electric Medical College, St. Louis 1877-78 about which time his attention was

forcibly directed to homoeopathy through serious illness of his wife, whose case refused to yield to other treatment except homoeopathy. He then become a careful student of hahnemann's Organon of Medicine, which resulted in his complete conversion to Homoeopathy. He taught at dunham, Hering and Hahnemann Medical College etc.

Contribution :- He was the author of the famous book "Lectures on Homoeopathic Philosophy" and "Repertory of Homoeopathic Materia Medica
