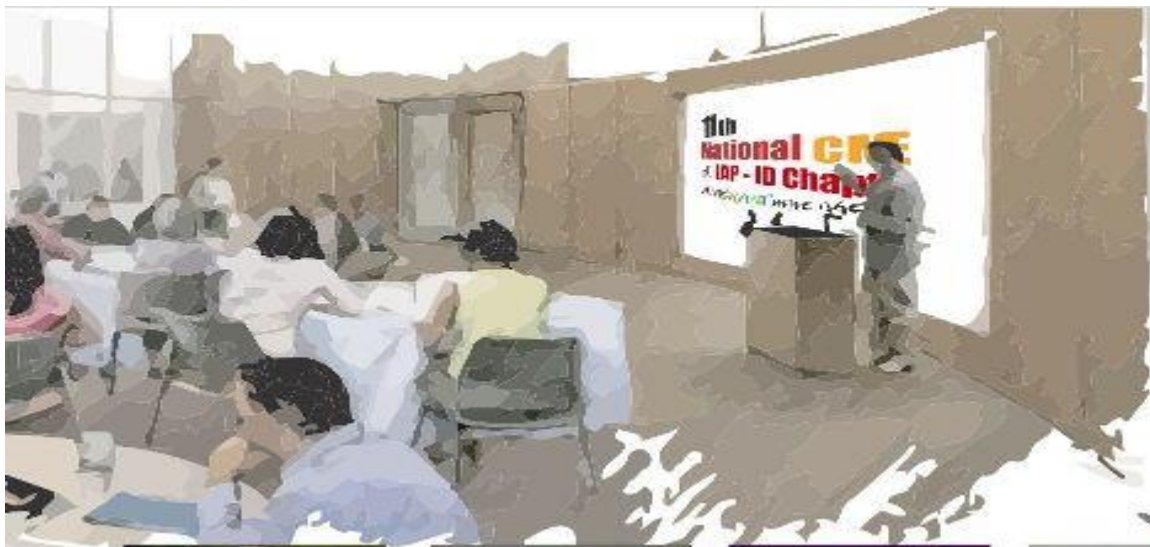

## DWARAKA

Dwaraka is of mythological importance as it was the capital of Lord Krishna to where he had migrated from Mathura region. The original Dwaraka and four other succeeding it, are supposed to have been submerged by the sea. The present Dwaraka is the sixth city on the site. It is a sacred place and centre of pilgrimage for Hindus because of its association with Lord Krishna. Here Lord Krishna's birthday Janmashtami is celebrated with great religious fervor and gaiety. Adi Shankaracharya established the 'Dwaraka Peeth' for spreading the message of the Hindu gospel 'Ramayana' in Dwaraka. The great mystic Narsinh Mehta, Mirabai and the great saints Kabir and Nanak have also visited Dwaraka.

## SARANGPUR

The image of Hanuman here is a stout figure with a handlebar moustache, crushing a female demon under his foot and baring his teeth, standing among sculpted foliage full of fruit bearing monkey attendants.

## SASAN GIR

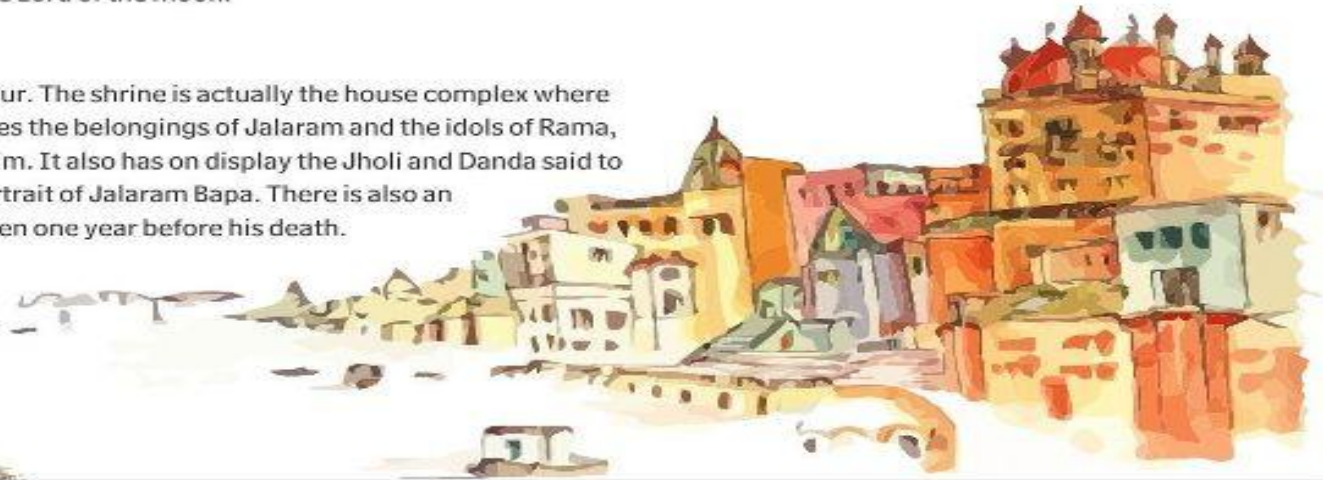
Sasan Gir Lion Sanctuary, which lies on the southwestern fringes of the Saurashtra Peninsula (west-central India), is the last home of some 300 Asiatic lions. It was created in 1913 to protect the largest surviving groups of the Asiatic lions. It was given a sanctuary status in 1965. Close to being an extinct species, the number of Asiatic lions has been steadily rising since 1980 in this safe haven. The vegetation in the area consists of teak with a mixture of deciduous trees, including sal (Shorea), dhak (Butea frondosa), and thorn forests. The terrain is rugged with steep rocky hillsides. A few springs also exist, but their flow is rather eccentric depending upon the season.

## SOMNATH

This temple is believed to be one of the twelve Shiv jyotirlingas. It is dedicated to Siva. It has an interesting legend about why and how it was built. It was built by the moon god or Soma in agreement to the curse that king Daksha put on him. He is said to have loved Rohini more than his other wives who incidentally were also Daksha's daughters. Due to the curse the moon began to fade and Daksha advised Soma to visit the Prabhas to get rid of the curse. Somnath etymologically mean the Lord of the moon.

## VIRPUR

The main shrine of Jalaram Bapa is located at Virpur. The shrine is actually the house complex where Jalaram lived during his lifetime. The shrine houses the belongings of Jalaram and the idols of Rama, Sita, Lakshmana and Hanuman worshipped by him. It also has on display the Jholi and Danda said to be given by God. But the main attraction is the portrait of Jalaram Bapa. There is also an actual black and white photo of Jalaram Bapa, taken one year before his death.

The Union territory of DIU (& Daman) once upon a collective union territory of Goa, Daman & Diu, an island in Arabian sea kissing the saurashtra peninsula has a beauty of more than 10 sea beaches at their best. Long held by Portuguese the effect of Portuguese architecture is clearly visible here. An exotic getaway, Diu may provide you the best of fun & frolic with nature at its best.

### Full Day Rajkot Sightseeing Tour

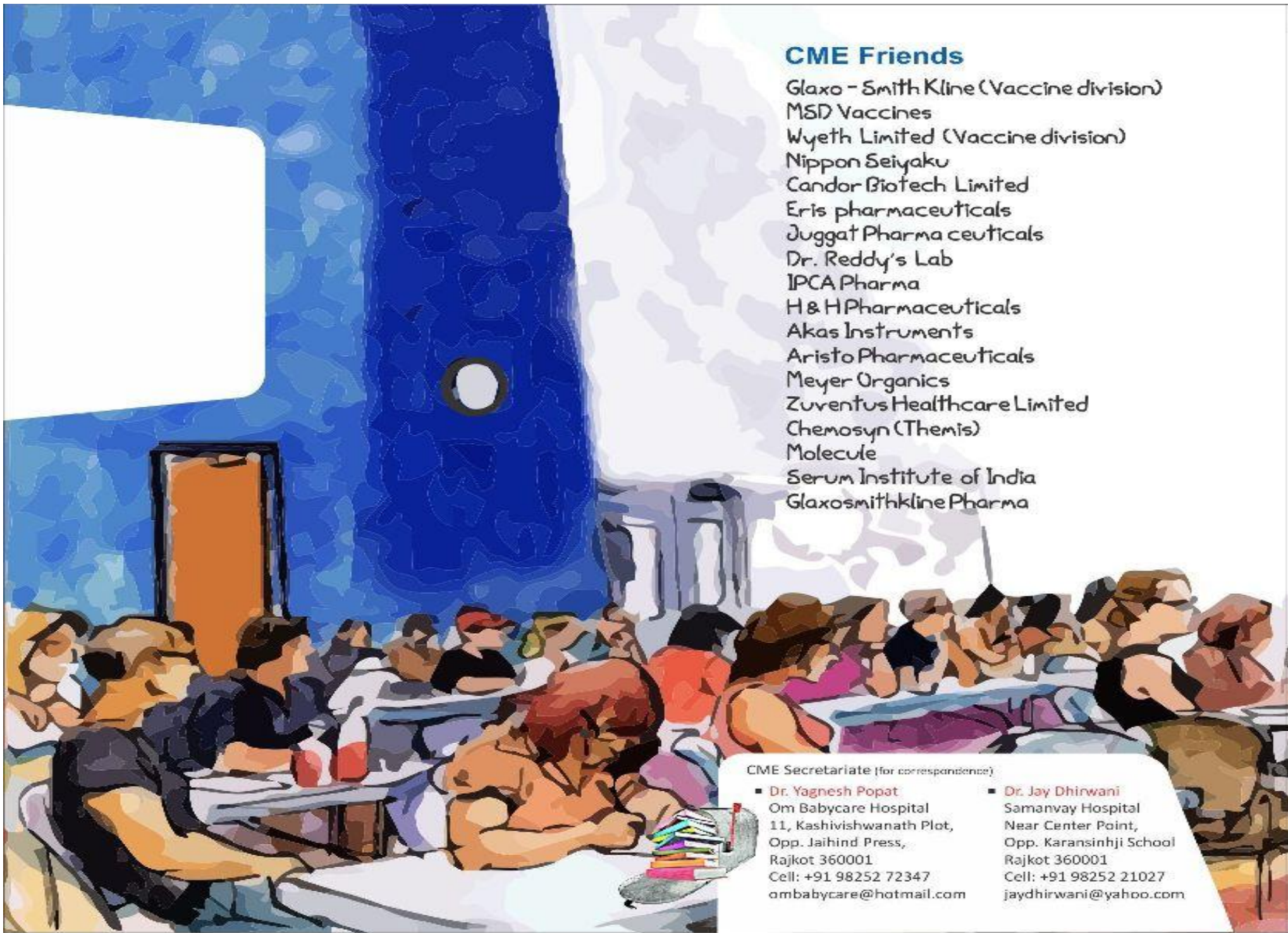
