GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

- Abstract must be submitted in English, Font size 12pt, Times New Roman.
- Abstract title to be limited to 20 words in BOLD UPPER CASE
- The abstract text to be limited to 500 words and is to be structured with the following headings: (in bold)
 1. Introduction
 2. Material & Methods
 3. Results
 4. Conclusions
- Please do not include tables, graphs and images in the abstract.
- Presenting authors of abstract must be registered participants.
- Abstracts must be original and must not be or have been published or presented at any other meeting.
- **Abstracts must be received by 31st January 2016**
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.
- Abstracts stating “data will be discussed in the presentation” will NOT be accepted.

NOTE:

- **REGISTRATION FEES WILL BE 1000 RS LESS FOR PG STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN PAPER, POSTER OR QUIZ COMPETITION.**
- **Registration for the conference is mandatory for submission of abstract.**

- **Only online submissions of Abstracts will be accepted.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER PRESENTATION

- Time allotted for the paper presentation is 5 minutes followed by 2 min discussion.
- It should be a power point presentation.
- The first slide should contain title of paper, name of the presenter and name of the institute.
- Only one entry per delegate in each category-free paper and poster allowed.
- Papers received after the last date of submission will not be accepted.
- The scientific committee has the final right to accept or reject a paper.
- All papers must be sent by email.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

- The size of poster should be 3' x 2'.
- Layout may be vertical or horizontal.
- Font size should be such that it is readable from a distance of 1 meter.
- Topic to be mentioned at the top of the poster.
- Name and photo of the presenter should appear in right upper corner.
- If the presenter is a PG student, he/she should not mention name of the guide.
- Please bring your own sticking material to display the poster at the designated area.
- The presenter will have to display the poster in the designated area by 12 noon on Sunday 20th February 2016.
